



SUPPLEMENTAL NOTES ON STALL PROCEDURE

To set your locomotive's stall voltage, remove the small cover plate located at the bottom of CAB-1. Power up the locomotive. Press the SET button located inside. Track power will go to zero. Power up your locomotive; it'll only reach half power once SET has been pressed. Reduce the locomotive's speed until it *just* stops. Press SET again. Power up the throttle, and your locomotive will commence stall-voltage operations. *Note:* Because every reverse unit is different, set the stall voltage each time you change locomotives. *Warning:* use low momentum when setting stall voltages.
