



Exploding Boxcar

Congratulations on your purchase of the Lionel Exploding Boxcar! This Lionel classic is the perfect complement to the rocket-launching Minuteman Car (available separately, no. 6-26762), exploding on contact when struck by a missile or another object. Watch as pieces of the boxcar fly apart, then reassemble it for more action!

Caution! A mousetrap-like mechanism is triggered to cause this car to “explode.” When the mechanism is set, keep your fingers out of the path of the metal arm. The mechanism can go off at anytime. Do not allow children to operate or set the Exploding Boxcar.

Setting the Exploding Boxcar




Figure 1. Setting the spring arm

1. Pull the spring arm back into the trigger mechanism as illustrated in Figure 1. Spring tension should hold the spring in place until the locking pin is inserted in the next step.

Caution! At this point, keep your fingers clear of the spring arm.




Figure 2. Inserting the roof and locking pin

2. Place the roof onto the boxcar as illustrated in Figure 2 and insert the locking pin through the holes in the roof and the frame. This will lock the trigger in place.




Figure 3. Inserting the sides

3. Place the sides into position as illustrated in Figure 3. When attaching the sides, tilt them inward slightly so that the tabs on the sides can easily slide into the slots in the frame. Lift the roof slightly as you position each side, then reposition the roof so that it holds the side in place. The tabs at the top of the sides should be under the roof.

Note! The sides are NOT interchangeable. Use the spacing between the tabs on the boxcar sides and the slots in the frame to guide you as you assemble the sides.

Triggering the Exploding Boxcar

Fire when ready! Carefully remove the locking pin, then strike the side of the boxcar with an object. The boxcar will fly into pieces!

Caution! Keep your hands and face clear of the boxcar when it is triggered. Watch out for the spring arm and flying pieces of the car!

Limited Warranty/Lionel Service

This Lionel product, including all mechanical and electrical components, moving parts, motors and structural components, except for light bulbs, is warranted to the original consumer-purchaser, for one year against original defects in materials or workmanship when purchased through an authorized Lionel merchant.

This warranty does NOT cover normal wear and tear, light bulbs, defects appearing in the course of commercial use, or damage resulting from abuse or misuse of the product by the purchaser. Transfer of this product by the original consumer-purchaser to another person voids this warranty. Modification of this product voids this warranty.

Any warranted product which is defective in original materials or workmanship and is delivered by the original consumer-purchaser to Lionel L.L.C. or an authorized Lionel L.L.C. Service Center, together with proof of original purchase will, at the option of Lionel L.L.C., be repaired or replaced, without charge for parts or labor. In the event the defective product cannot be repaired, and a replacement is not available, a refund of the original purchase price will be granted. Any products on which warranty service is sought must be sent freight or postage prepaid, as transportation and shipping charges are not covered by the warranty.

In no event shall Lionel L.L.C. be liable for incidental or consequential damages.

Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above exclusion may not apply to you.

This limited warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may have other rights which vary from state to state.

Instructions for Obtaining Service

If service for this Lionel L.L.C. product is required, bring the item, along with your dated sales receipt and completed warranty information to the nearest Authorized Lionel Service Center. Your nearest Lionel Service Center can be found by calling 1-800-4-Lionel, or by accessing our Website at www.lionel.com.

If you prefer to send your product back to Lionel L.L.C. for repair in Michigan,

you must first call 586-949-4100 or FAX 586-949-5429, or write to Customer Service, P.O. Box 748, New Baltimore, MI 48047-0748, stating what the item is, when it was purchased and what seems to be the problem. You will be sent a return authorization letter and label to ensure your merchandise will be properly handled upon receipt.

Once you have received your return authorization and label, make sure that the item is packed to prevent damage during shipping and handling. We suggest that you use the product's original packaging. This shipment must be prepaid and we recommend that it be insured.

Please make sure you have followed all of the above instructions carefully before returning any merchandise for service. You may choose to have your product repaired by one of our Authorized Lionel Service Centers after its warranty has expired. A reasonable service fee will be charged.
